Quota is known especially for service empowering women and children and to people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, and speech-impaired. Our scholarship program provides grants to eligible post high school students who are deaf, hearing or speech impaired OR students majoring in Speech Pathology/Audiology/Deaf Education. Candidates must have excellent grades and a demonstrated financial need. They may apply for our scholarship over multiple years. Seven students from the University of Northern Iowa majoring in Communication Sciences & Disorders (Speech Pathology) were awarded a Quota scholarship from our Hearing & Speech Committee in April.
